- Kindergarten, 1st Grade, or 2nd Grade
- Most recent report card or progress report card reflecting below level or unsatisfactory in Reading
- Must attend all 5 sessions if selected after registration and lottery drawing

If your child has a current IEP, attends Saturday School or HOST program, they will not be eligible for this program.

Each session will consist of reading instruction and activities and will last 60 minutes (50 minutes of instruction and 10 minutes for caregiver feedback).
