| Center Programming and Center Appearance | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Success 4kids Presentation: Program is community based that covers 2 areas. One is Healthy Start which conducts home visits for women who are pregnant. The other program covers children 5 years old up to high school students called Children Mental Health Services. Both are at home and case managers are assigned if needed. They cover any mental health issue. Edna is the intake coordinator and can be reached by calling 813-490-5490. The Counseling program at the center has funding until September. They will be reapplying and they are looking at ways to improve/expand services. The focus is in this area and primary in the homes/community. Families mentioned the issue with transportation, money for therapies, flexible schedule for parents not have to miss work- in the after school hours and weekends, accessible for high risk families, expand it to younger than 5 years of age which covers other issues such as: Education- need tutoring, help in reading, parents need to learn how education system works- very complicated. Parents may lack basic education and may not know how to read/write, need a one stop place where they can access info. They are looking into a type of system navigator who may be able to assist parents with this. Proposals are due on 3/9.
