<b>Center Programming and Center Appearance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Presentation by Prevent Vision: Pilar Bradley spoke to FCAC the importance of having a vision screening at least once a year. Adults can get their eyes checked at La Esperanza Clinic at Wimauma and they will work with surrounding agencies to identify low cost for client (beginning at \$35). Children who are seen at the center do not need to have any insurance or social. They can have Medicaid and child would be referred to their provider if glasses needed. But if child has no assistance, Preserve Vision can assist with grants they receive.</li> <li>S4FK: Jorge Villada introduced the new counselor, Janice Perez. She will be at the center on Monday and Tuesday at SC and Wednesday-Friday at Plant City. Individuals with no insurance and have a child birth to 8<sup>th</sup> grade in the home (13) can qualify anyone in the family to see the counselor.
