Ruskin library is also doing a reading promotion that the children will receive a free book once they complete certain amount of reading.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enterprising Latinas is having their Grand Opening on 6/26 at 11am. They will be offering CNA classes for mothers in the areas of Ruskin, Balm, Sun City and Wimauma areas. They have hired a new person, Jean Arias who is the new Family Support Manager and is assisting individuals 18 and up with GED. They will continue their certification class for women to have their own business selling food with Wimauma Eats. Sewing together is an 8 week class where it teaches women to sew and have their own business along with Rising Woman's Network where they meet once a month and have different topics of discussion. They meet the last Thursday of the month from 6-7pm and no childcare is available. There was also discussion of scholarships being available for children 8-14 years old to attend the Firehouse summer arts program. They would need to have reduced/free lunch, a letter of support from an organization and a letter from their child as to how they would benefit. • There was also discussion regarding the Back to School Fair for physicals and vaccinations. Last several years, families have attended to obtain school supplies but once event took place, they were told that they could not receive them unless receiving physicals and shots.
