Families that need help with their case are encouraged to come during the scheduled time. • Local school information: It has come to our attention that Shields Middle School will be moving towards uniforms for this school year. Parents are to purchase a polo with the schools signage at their school. Shirts are \$10 and if parents are in need of financial assistance, we were told to ask for their social worker or their school counselor. Ruskin also has uniforms but it is just certain colored polo shirts with no signage on front. • Ms. Isabelle with the Ruskin Library announced that their last show will be on Friday at 10 am @ Firehouse.
